

Minutes of the Meeting of District Development Coordination & Monitoring Committee(DISHA) held on 14.08.2016 in the Conference Hall (at 3rd floor) of District Administrative Building, Nadia.

Sri Tapas Paul, Hon'ble M.P. & Chairperson, DDCMC(DISHA), Nadia, in his inaugural speech, welcomes all members for attending the meeting. As it is the 1st meeting of the newly constituted committee, a brief introduction session was there.

Thereafter the agenda of the meeting was placed through Power Point Presentation by the concerned officers of respective Departments.

The following points emerged after interaction with the members:

I) MGNREGS (Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme):

The District Nodal Officer, Nadia put forward the achievements under MGNREGS.

He added that focus is given on Asset creation as per the guidelines of MoRD and increase of women's participation in all aspects of MGNREGS related works. He also inform all members that Nadia was ranked 1st among all districts in West Bengal in MGNREGS in previous year and holding the position jointly with Hooghly district this year till date as per parameters fixed by the MoRD, GoI.

Then he put forward about some major initiatives of Nadia district in front of the members such as Fly Ash Bricks Production Units, Cat fish production in Chakdaha, different fruit plantation under IBS mode, Organic village Development, Girl Child Benefit Scheme and above all the project 'Sabujayan' i.e. vetiver plantation in the vulnerable river embankments of the district to protect the embankment which was already got appreciation from renowned persons like Dr. Paul Turong, Technical Director, The Vetiver Network International, Australia; Mr. P. Vincent, Vetiver Expert, Tamilnadu; Prof. Dibyendu Sarkar, Stevens Institute of Technology, New Jersey, USA and Prof. Rupali Dutta, Michigan Technological University, USA who came to visit the initiatives taken by the District MGNREGS Cell of Nadia in recent times.

He also stated that only 204 lakh person days with average person days of 59.19 have been achieved in the last FY-2015-16. In the current FY-2016-17 also, Nadia District achieved Labour Budget Target upto July. It also mentioned that Rs. 78.74 crore pending liability yet to make payment for both the FYs for the District.

II) IAY (Indira Awas Yojana) & PMAY (Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana):

On the instruction of District Magistrate, Nadia, DP & RDO, Nadia presented the IAY & PMAY report.

He states that the highest no. of IAY was sanctioned to Nadia district last year due to the good performance of the district in previous years. Completion cases are also highest among the districts.

Now the scheme has been replaced with PMAY & the amount of the scheme increased from Rs. 70000.00 to 120000.00, but it is in the beginning phase and no sanction has been received yet.
