**Order under Section 144 Cr. P.C.**

WHEREAS, the Election Commission vide Press release Note No.536-SEC/IE-99/2021(Pt-I) Dated-3<sup>rd</sup> Day of February,2022 declared the schedule for Municipal General Election-2022 for Nadia District and the said Election will be held on 27.02.2022 in Krishnagar Municipality, Nabadwip Municipality, Birnagar Municipality, Taherpur NA, Ranaghat Municipality, Santipur Municipality, Chakdaha Municipality, Haringhata Municipality, Gayeshpur Municipality, Nabadwip Municipality falling under Krishnagar Police District and Ranaghat Police District of Nadia District.

AND WHEREAS, there is every reason to believe that unknown miscreants may create disorder and trouble in and around the Polling Station premises falling under the mentioned above, which may hamper the process of conducting Poll in free and fair manner;

AND WHEREAS, it appears that such action of the miscreants may also cause breach of peace and public tranquility in the neighborhood of the Polling Station premises;

AND WHEREAS, it appears that there is sufficient ground for proceeding u/Sec. 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for prevention of such nuisance or apprehended danger.

NOW THEREFORE , I, Shashank Sethi, I.A.S., District Magistrate, Nadia, in exercise of the power conferred upon the undersigned u/Sec. 144 CrPC, do hereby direct the following in the entire Jurisdiction of area falling under Krishnagar Police District and Ranaghat Police District of Nadia District for the period from 06:00 A.M of 26.02.2022 till departure of polling parties from the respective Polling Station :-

1. There shall be no Assembly of 5(Five) persons or more, excluding the voters in queue, within 200 mts. periphery from the boundary of the Polling Station premises.
2. The owners of houses and other establishments within 200 mts. periphery from the boundary of the Polling Station premises shall not allow any unauthorized persons to Assemble in their houses and establishments.
3. No booth of Contesting Candidates or Political Parties shall be set up within 200 mts. periphery from the boundary of the Polling Station premises
4. Nobody shall carry firearms, other weapons, lathis etc. within 200mts. periphery from the boundary of the Polling Station premises.
5. There shall be no parking of vehicles near gate of the Polling Station premises.
6. Microphones, loudspeakers etc. shall not be used in the vicinity of Polling Station premises (within 200mts. and beyond) in such a manner that it hampers the process of Poll.
7. Any other activity which may disturb the process of Poll, shall remain strictly prohibited within 200mts. periphery from the boundary of the Polling Station premises.

This order shall, however, not apply to the officials engaged in the enforcement of Law and Order, conduct of Election and maintenance of essential services.

Any persons violating the order shall be punishable u/Sec. 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

The order is being issued ex-party u/Sec. 144 (2) Cr.PC.

The Superintendent of Police, Krishnagar Police District and Ranaghat Police District is requested to communicate this order to the Inspector-in-Charge and Officer-in-Charge of the Police Station of his jurisdiction with a direction to implement the order.
