Advocate Soumen Biswas for Awardee, Kamal Kumar Saha & 8 others states that the instant Mouja Baruihuda and Paschim Bhatjangla/Dakshin Jitkipota are situated face to face on two sides of the N.H.34. Hence he prays to grant the same rate as was ordered in Mouja Paschim Bhatjangla and Dakshin Jitkipota.	•
	Ld. Advocate, Jayashree Paul for Saroj Kr. Roy, Pankaj Roy, Tulshi Rani Roy, Bina Roy, Brojogopal Saha and Shyamal Kr. Basak states that 5 dec. homestead land of Mouja Baruihuda was sold in the year 2010 at Rs. 12 lakh. Hence the rate of Bari/Viti per dec. stands Rs. 2.40 lakh. In another Registered Deed 2 dec. of Bari/Viti was transferred at Rs. 9 lakh in the year 2013. Hence the rate of Bari/Viti per dec. comes to Rs. 4.5 lakh He appeals to consider the Registered Deeds while passing the order of Arbitration.	
signed by me	Verified the applications, Rate Report, Plot Index, Sale data of ADSR, Block-Map, Comparative Chart of rates and viewed the Vediography of the locality and found that Mouja Baruihuda and Paschim Bhatjangla / Dakshin Jitkapota are situated face to face. The Mouja Baruihuda bears almost the same status as Paschim Bhatjangla and Dakshin Jitkipota. Hence, rate of the Mouja Baruihuda can not be much different than that of Paschim Bhatjangla and Dakshin Jitkipota. The rate of Bari/Viti of the Mouja Paschim Bhatjangla was primarily approved at the rate of Rs. 99,71,070/-by the Competent Authority while after Arbitration the rate of Bari/Viti of Mouja Paschim Bhatjangla & Dakshin Jitkipota has been fixed at Rs. 1,45,000/-per dec. As positional advantage of all the Moujas are more or less equal, the rate of Baruihuda should be enhanced keeping parity with the other Moujas.	
Madia	Hence, I think the rate of Bari/Viti of Mouja Baruihuda may be taken as Rs.1,40,000/- per acre, a bit lower than Paschim Bhatjangla.	
rbitrator u/s I	In presence of the General Manager (Tech.) & Project Director, National Highways Authority of India, Krishnagar, Nadia and Ld. Advocate Abhik Chakraboty in favour of N.H.A.I the rate is announced. On the other hand, he applicants are found agreed with the rate also.	

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## Hence, it is ordered that :-

- 1] The rate of Bari/Viti class of land will be taken as Rs.14250000/- per acre instead of Rs.9971078/- per acre.
- 2] The rate of other classes will remain the same.
- 3] All the rest awardees who have failed to submit arbitration petitions due to ignorance or otherwise but having the same classes of land as mentioned above will also be entitled to the arbitral award as a principle of natural justice.

Thus, Twenty Two [22] arbitration petitions are disposed of.
