**NOTICE INVITING TENDER**

Sealed tenders are invited from authorized experienced and bonafide Distributor/Dealers / Agencies for supplying the following articles for use of the Disaster Management Section, Nadia Collectorate. The intending Distributor/Dealers /Agencies are requested to submit the Tender maintaining the specification of the item and rate separately. The articles /Equipments must be of best quality from reputed manufacturers having acceptability in the sphere of Govt. / undertaken / large company .

The tenders in sealed cover will be received from 06.03.2017 to 20.03.2017 from 11-00 A.M to 3.00 P.M on all working days in the chamber of the Officer-in-charge, Disaster Management Section, Nadia Collectorate "A" Block, 2<sup>nd</sup>. Floor and will be opened on 20.03.2017 at 4-00 P.M at the chamber of Officer-in-charge. Disaster Management Section, Nadia. Collectorate.

**Specification of articles.**

Name of articles Specification	Quantity
<p><b>Diver's Suit.</b> The Under Water Diving Set shall be used for purpose of under-water rescue diving jobs / under water work by emergency response teams. Each set should consist of following items:</p> <p>1. <b>The Under Water Breathing Apparatus Set</b> complete with a <b>FULL FACE MASK</b> designed for underwater utilization for emergency, commercial &amp; technical uses. The mask should be comfortable &amp; weight be restricted to 900 grams. The mask should have a wide-view vision visor and the shape should allow even for use of spectacles for the wearer. It should be adaptable to allow the mask to "float" comfortably on the face and allow the mask to fit most of face structures. The visor should be made of transparent polycarbonate with the optical part wider and closer to the face to maximize the visual field, particularly the peripheral area. The visor will be scratch &amp; impact resistant. The head harness should have 6 straps – all directly attached to the face shield in a design that allows the pressure to be transmitted uniformly along the mask's skirt. The face mask should be equipped with a Surface Valve allowing the diver to breathe fresh air when on surface and save precious tank air. Face mask should also have provision to connect communication system in future if desired. The face mask should be complete with an <b>INTEGRATED 2nd stage DEMAND VALVE</b> having Dive &amp; Pre-Dive adjustments. It should be connected to the 1 st stage via a breather hose. The <b>1st stage REGULATOR</b> should have balanced diaphragm and anti-freeze kit. It should have an adjustable intermediate pressure and should be made of brass with a plated chromed finish body and stainless steel piston. It should have 4 LP and 2 HP ports. <u>The mask-regulator should be CE marked and Certified to EN-250 standard. Copy of certificate to be submitted with offer.</u></p> <p>2. A <b>PRESSURE GAUGE</b>, which shall be connected to the 1st stage of the regulator to check the pressure of air in the cylinders.</p> <p>3. A <b>BREATHING AIR TANK</b> made of Alloy material, which will have a water volume of 11 litres and will be designed to operate to 200 Bar pressure.</p>	<p>2 (Two) Nos of Diver's Suit</p>

4. A molded light weight fiber **BACK PACK** with adjustable shoulder straps, quick-release buckles, tank harness that can be adjusted to hold the tank, and with non-slip internal support.
5. The dive suit should be a **WET SUIT** in heat-reflecting 5 mm neoprene in a two-piece design viz. LongJohn + Jacket closed by a convenient front zipper and a separate **HOOD**. Wrist, ankle and face seals will be watertight.
6. A pair of five-fingered heat reflecting **GLOVES** with neoprene double lining.
7. A pair of **BOOTS**, which should be comfortable & heat-reflecting with 5 mm neoprene lining, non-slip soles and nylon side zipper.
8. The set must also include **BUOYANCY COMPENSATOR DEVICE (BCD)**, which will act as back plate to hold the Tank as well as BCD. It will be made of high strength CORDURA 1000D outer material and NYLON 420D inner bladder. It will come with 3 rapid dumping Valves and 2 over pressure valves.
9. Scope will also include a **WEIGHT BELT** with SS buckle and 2 Nos. 2 kg or 4 Nos. 1 kg "H" type **LEAD WEIGHTS**.
10. An **underwater Torch**.

**PREQUALIFICATIONS:**

The bidder will be the authorized distributor of the manufacturer of these diving equipment and a copy of the same will be submitted with the offer. The bidder will be in this field for the last at least 5 years and should have supplied atleast 100 nos. of basic Under Water Diving BA Set to various disaster search & rescue teams police / fire departments / Navy / Coast Guard in the last 5 years, all over India. Copy of these purchase orders will be submitted with the bid.

A sum of Rs. 30,000=00 ( Rupees thirty thousand) only is to be deposited through Bank Draft / pay order as Earnest Money in favour of District Magistrate, Nadia at the time of Submission of tender Paper which will subsequently be returned as Security Deposit and the same will be kept in the Office of the undersigned if he is selected for supplying any of the articles.
7. If he fails to supply the articles within 7(seven) days from the date of order the security deposit will be forfeited.
8. The successful bidder has to show the sample after completion of the bidding procedure. The supply order will be issued only after verifying the sample.
9. The accepted rate will be applicable for the office of the Collector & District Magistrate, Nadia.

10. Payment will be made only after supplying of products as per accepted specifications and quality.
11. The quoted rate to be given both figure and words and include the transportation cost upto District Headquarter Krishnagar.
12. Selected suppliers will have to execute an agreement in Non-Judicial Stamp paper of Rs. 10/- as to smooth & timely completion of the assigned works.
