

Online tenders item wise in two bid systems (Technical and Financial) are invited for supply of Spectacles with power Glass as per specification annexed for the year 2019-2020 & for the subsequent year if renewed for 2 more years. The tender must be submitted online on the State Government e-tender portal <https://wbtenders.gov.in> before last date & time of submission of tender i.e. on 08/07/2019 at 05.00 P.M.

1) Procurement:

The Chief Medical Officer of Health, Nadia will procure Spectacles with power Glass for approximately 34,839 (Thirty Four Thousand Eight Hundred and thirty nine) number for School Eye Screening Student in Nadia district. The tender will consist of the following work

Supply of Spectacles with power Glass for School Eye Screening Student of Nadia district. The supply of 34839 (thirty four thousand eight hundred and thirty nine) spectacles will be done **“as to be ordered as per requirement basis”**. Hence the quantity is only tentative & may vary accordingly.

2. Terms and Conditions:

The rates must be quoted for items including all applicable taxes and charges otherwise this will be cancelled. The rates quoted in respect of items shall not exceed the controlled price and or MRP fixed by G.O.I as below.

Supply of Spectacles with power Glass for School Eye Screening Student-Rs. 350/- (three hundred and fifty) per spectacle

The Tenderer must submit online Technical bid and Financial Bid in English language.

3. EMD:

An earnest money of Rs.35000/-(Thirty five thousand) only for participation in tender for Spectacles with power Glass for School Eye Screening Student is to be deposited online by the bidder in the way as described in Memorandum No.-3975-F(Y), dt.-28/7/16 of Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal.

Security Money:

After issuance of letter of acceptance, a Security money of Rs. 1,00,000/-(One Lakh) only for tender for Spectacles with power Glass for School Eye Screening Student is to be deposited by successful bidder for concerned items in the form of a demand draft drawn from any scheduled nationalized bank in favour of 'The Secretary, District Health & Family Welfare Samity' payable at Krishnagar, Nadia within the specified time period mentioned in the letter of acceptance. Non submission of security money will lead to forfeiture of earnest money of the concerned bidder. Security Money may be retained up to one year from the acceptance of tender or up to the end of work tenure whichever is later. Supply/procurement order will be issued to the concerned bidder only after successful deposition of performance security by the concerned bidder.

4. The tenderer should submit the tender in following two bids:

A) Technical Proposal: containing Statutory Cover and Non-statutory Cover:-

Statutory cover:

1. Application to participate in e-tender as per annexed proforma.
2. Scanned copy of proof of submission of EMD in the way as described in Memorandum No.-3975-F(Y), dt.-28/7/16 of Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal /valid order from competent authority in support of exemption or relaxation claimed for EMD, if any.

Non-statutory cover: will contain the following documents:

A: Certificate (s):

1. Income Tax return (Financial year 2017-2018 i.e. assessment year 2018-2019)
2. PAN card of proprietor/company whichever is available
3. Professional Tax enrolment certificate valid on the last date of online bid submission
4. GST Registration Certificate.
5. Co-operative Registration (applicable for Co-operative Societies) valid on the last date of online bid submission

B: Company Details:

1. Updated Trade license valid on the last date of online bid submission
2. Power of Attorney in favour of signatory of bid if needed
3. Registration certificate with Registrar of Companies (if applicable) valid on the last date of online bid submission

C: Credential:

Experience and past performance on contracts of spectacles in Government Department/PSUs (Documentary evidence to be submitted). Credential having actual work done within last five years from the date of issuance of this tender notice will be accepted. The performance is to be submitted in the annexed "Statement of Performance" proforma. Value of job must be at least 15% of amount put to tenders & multiple credentials may be added for the same.

D. Documents:

1. Bank solvency certificate on any date after publishing of this e-tender for an amount equal to Rs. 300000/- (Three Lakhs) or above (Name & A/C no of the A/C holder must be mentioned.)
2. Bidders' non-conviction certificate as per enclosed proforma

B) Financial proposal: Rate:

Rates quoted in respect of items shall not exceed the controlled price and/or M.R.P i.e. Rs.350/- (Three Hundred Fifty) for per piece spectacles of School Eye Screening Student. The basic rate per accounting unit will be quoted inclusive of all applicable taxes and charges such as Entry Tax, Transportation, Delivery Charges, Insurance (if applicable). Financial bid of the tenderer will be opened only if he is found qualified in technical bid.

5. The tenderer should quote only one rate for one item as per specification. Rates for separate items to be considered separately for selection.
6. The rates tendered must remain valid for a period of one year with effect from the date of acceptance of the tender. The renewal will be done on the basis of the satisfactory performance only in the same rate as quoted. However, the contract may be extended up to maximum 2 years breaking in two (2) successive 1 year's durations subject to satisfactory performance of the selected bidder, if required, on mutually agreed terms.
7. The tenderer should give warranty against any item supplied by them and replace the defective item at their own cost within 15 days of supply to the beneficiary in case of manufactural defects as would be decided by District level authority.
8. The tender selection committee nominated by the Competent Authority to assess eligibility shall carry out the evaluation of bids.
